### Upcoming works on Badgerys Creek Road and Elizabeth Drive

Dear neighbour,

Early earthworks for the Western Sydney Airport are continuing with a range of works scheduled to be delivered over the coming months, including:

- realignment of Badgerys Creek Road,
- construction of the Badgerys Creek Road Bridge,
- construction of a new roundabout at Elizabeth Drive,
- continued bulk earthworks, and
- utility works.

### Badgerys Creek Road realignment and bridge construction

Road realignment and earthworks activities will continue on Badgerys Creek Road between Elizabeth Drive and Longleys Road. The construction of the new Badgerys Creek Road Bridge will include the installation of 21 super-T girders each weighing around 45 tonnes.

To reduce impacts on road users, the girders will be delivered early in the morning starting **Tuesday 7 May 2019**. They will be delivered under escort due to the requirement to use oversize vehicles for transport.

### **Elizabeth Drive roundabout**

To facilitate the connection to the new alignment of Badgerys Creek Road, a roundabout will be constructed on Elizabeth Drive.

This work will occur over multiple stages with clear signage and traffic control in place at all times. Some works may need to be completed outside of normal construction hours, and we will provide a detailed community notification before the work commences.

### Traffic changes on local roads

Traffic changes will be in place while works are being delivered on Elizabeth Drive and Badgerys Creek Road. Speed limits may vary from time to time to ensure the safety of motorists and workers.

Additionally, any plant or machinery crossing Badgerys Creek Road will be carried out under strict traffic control.




Early Earthworks | May – June 2019
